We are committed to ensure that individual's rights are honored. We serve as the primary contact for parents, guardians and family members and help to address any concerns that may arise or for general support and reassurance.

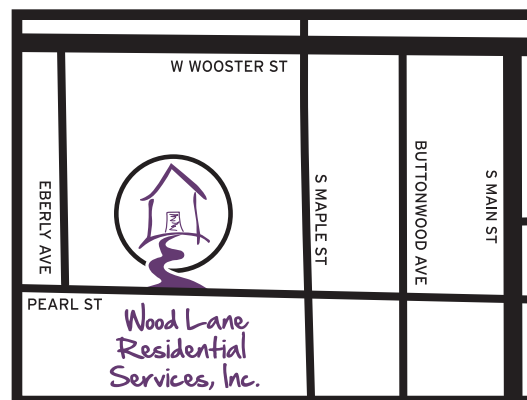

Respect for all Individuals Behavior Shaping

Individuals who have challenging behavioral difficulties can be assured that staff are extensively trained in an approach known as "Behavior Shaping." This program is based on "Capability Teaching" by the late Lee Graber. It is a proven approach to meeting individual needs in this area.

The concept is simple: individuals with behavioral difficulties are taught strategies and given choices to help empower them to more effectively manage their lives.

Staff interact with individuals with genuine understanding and sensitivity. They also strive to help individuals learn to make good choices and to become as independent as possible.



Short-term Respite Care Available

Short-term care is available for youth and adults in our respite home. This service can be used for, but is not limited to an overnight retreat or a preplanned vacation. Respite services are also designed for family emergencies. Staff ensure that individuals have the opportunity to participate in community activities during their stay. Staff are trained to meet each person's needs which may include but are not limited to special diets or medication administration.

Help For Working Families:

Working parents can rely on us for quality and reliable care until their work day is over.

Extended care is an after school service for students who attend Wood Lane School or the Wood County Educational Service Center's autism classes that are located at Wood Lane School. Families can rely on staff to provide a safe, friendly and relaxing atmosphere for their children.
